

Quiet hours from 10PM - 6AM.

Campground reminders:

Check out time is 2PM. Check in time is 3PM unless your reserved site is vacant and you've checked in with the campground manager.

Cancellations made 72 hours prior to check in will receive a refund less the \$6.00 convenience fee. Cancellations after that time will receive no refund. Reservations will be held for 24 hours unless notified by camper of later arrival. After 24 hours, site can be rented out to someone else and no refund will be given. Original reservations may be amended or modified as requested twice by the camper before the village exercises the right to cancel the entire reservation to ensure the availability of the site for other campers.

CAMPGROUND/SITE RULES

QUIET HOURS ARE BETWEEN 10 PM AND 7 AM. PLEASE BE COURTEOUS TO OTHER CAMPERS.

NO LOUD MUSIC, PROFANITY, USE OF WEAPON OR GUNS OR FIREWORKS

MODERATE DRINKING OF ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED AT CAMPSITES ONLY AND YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO SECURE ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHEN NOT AT YOUR CAMPSITE

PUBLIC INTOXICATION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL BE REPORTED TO THE POLICE. -The campground manager, in conjunction with local law enforcement, has the authority to evict campers who violate the above rules, local ordinance and/or State laws. Campers who are evicted from the Park shall receive NO refund and shall NOT be allowed to return to the Park.

PETS:

Limit of 2 pets/site

Pets MUST be leashed at all times and are not allowed in the restrooms

PET OWNERS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER PETS OR INCUR A 25.00 FINE

FISH CLEANING:

Thurston Park provides a Fish Cleaning House. Fish must be cleaned and scaled on paper. Soiled paper and fish cleanings must be placed in plastic bags, tied and deposited in the freezer. Please keep this area clean for all to enjoy.

MISCELLANEOUS:

1 RV AND 10X10 TENT ALLOWED ON EACH SITE, EXCEPTIONS MUST BE PRIOR APPROVED BY THE CAMPGROUND MANAGER

Boat trailers must be tagged and parked in Designated areas only. No boats or trailers to be parked on bluff sites.

Please do not move campfire rings without prior approval and keep campfires in the designated areas

All litter should be placed in plastic bags (provided by Thurston Park) and put in the dumpster

There is no lifeguard. Swim at your own risk. No jumping or diving off any dock.

NO RETAIL, SERVICE OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF BUSINESS IS TO BE CONDUCTED FROM CAMPGROUND SITES OR DOCKS.
