RESERVATIONS

The park opens the last Saturday in April and closes the first Saturday in October. Call (231) 544-6483 or (231) 676-8539 or visit <http://bit.ly/ThurstonPark> for reservations.

- You must be at least 18 years old to rent a campsite.
- All campers must check in with the Park Manager.
- Lake Front sites are a four-night minimum stay, Memorial Day to Labor Day, on the weekends.
- Lake Front sites have a 14-night maximum stay.
- Reservations are accepted on site if a site is available.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Full payment is expected at the time of reservation.

CAMPSITE REMINDERS

- Site 8 is a tent site only, unless prior authorized by management
- All sites have electric hookup
- Water available for fill sites 1-26
- Electric and water hookups are on sites 33-35
- Full hookup sites are 27-32 and 36-40
- NO TENTS ALLOWED on the bluff, unless permitted by the campground manager.

Check out time is **2 p.m.** Anyone on a lot after check out will be charged an additional day.

Cancellations made one-week prior to check in will receive a refund, less any fees. Cancellations made after that time will receive no refund.

Check in time is **3 p.m.**.

Reservations will be held for 24 hours unless notified by camper of later arrival. If there isn't notification the site will be held for 24 hours and rented out after 24 hours to another camper and no refund will be given.

CAMPSITE RULES

- ONLY ONE RV/TRAILER & ONE TENT NO LARGER THAN 10' X 10' PER SITE
- Any unit sleeping more than 6 persons will be charged an addition \$6/person/day
- Renters must contain all their equipment on their campsite
- Boat trailers must be tagged and parked in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.
- Five (5) mph speed limit throughout the park/campground.
- Campfires in designated areas only.
- All litter must be placed in plastic bags, tied and placed in the dumpster.
- Feeding of waterfowl is prohibited.
- **Absolutely NO campers are allowed in the water within ten (10) feet of the boat launch and/or dock.**
- **There is NO lifeguard. Swim at your own risk.**
- Mooring boats and other recreational equipment are strictly at the risk and responsibility of the owner.
- **NO RETAIL, SERVICE OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF BUSINESS IS TO BE CONDUCTED FROM CAMPGROUND SITES OR DOCKS**
- **NO POLITICAL SIGNS OF ANY NATURE ARE ALLOWED**

COURTEOUS CAMPING

We hope all of our campers enjoy their stay at Thurston Park. To ensure that this happens please be courteous to other campers.

- No loud music, profanity, use of weapons or air guns, or fireworks.
- Moderate drinking of alcohol is permitted at campsites only.
- Public intoxication will not be tolerated and will be reported to the police.
- Campers are responsible for securing all alcoholic beverages when not at their campsite. At no time shall coolers containing alcoholic beverages be left unattended or unsecured.
- Quiet hours are to be observed and will be enforced from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

PETS

- Limit of TWO pets per unit.
- Additional pets will be charged at \$25 per day/per pet.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and are NOT allowed in restroom.
- Length of leash shall not exceed six (6) feet.
- PET OWNER MUST CLEAN UP AFTER PET.

FISH CLEANING

- Thurston Park provides a Fish Cleaning House. Fish must be cleaned and scaled on paper. Soiled paper and fish cleanings must be placed in plastic bags, tied and deposited in the barrel in the Fish Cleaning House. Please keep this area clean.

Dock Rentals

- Price is \$5 per day
- Check out time is **2 p.m.** Anyone on a dock after check out will be charged an additional day.

The Park Manager, in conjunction with local law enforcement, has the authority to evict campers who violate the above rules, local ordinances and/or State laws.
